2. The completed application and five copies of the essay must be received by Brooks, LeBoeuf, Bennett, Foster & Gwartney, P.A., **by 5:00 p.m. on Friday, March 9, 2012.**
3. The essay must be a typewritten, original composition containing no less than 500 and no more than 1,000 words. The essay subject must be: The Bill of Rights: What it means to me as an American. No more than one essay per person. The essay may cover one, any combination or all of the first ten amendments to the Constitution.
4. Only one essay may be submitted per person.
5. No current or past employees or immediate family members of Brooks, LeBoeuf, Bennett, Foster and Gwartney, P.A. or the independent celebrity judges are eligible to enter the competition.
6. The top ten essays will be submitted to a panel of independent celebrity judges who will select the award winning essay: One scholarship in the amount of \$2,500 will be awarded directly to a high school junior or senior.
